Your information will be used for the following purposes:


Purpose 1: Development of academic and commercial courses

UHI NWH aims to contribute to the academic, cultural, and economic prosperity of Scotland and the UK. To contribute effectively we seek to develop academic and commercial courses that meet the needs of the students, businesses, organisations and the public.

To this end, UHI NWH undertakes programmes of engagement with local, regional and national businesses, organisations, experts and agencies to understand their current, and projected, skills and expertise needs so that academic and commercial courses can be planned to meet those needs.

The professional contact details (personal information) of individuals within those organisations will be held by UHI NWH in our Customer Relationship Management (CRM) system. Use of the CRM allows us to manage and co-ordinate engagement activity; for example, the CRM approach allows arrangements for one communication to be sent to a national organisation, rather than thirteen communications (one per university/college).

Our legal reason to use the data is: Use is necessary for the purposes of legitimate interests pursued by the UHI NWH. The legitimate interest being UHI NWH's interest in designing courses of academic and commercial study, and academic and commercial consulting products that contribute to the academic, cultural, and economic prosperity of Scotland and the UK. The personal data collected by UHI NWH will be used for the benefit of helping us identify the external demands and trends for educational and commercial products, in order that we can develop a curriculum and knowledge and research products that support and reflects the requirements of external organisations. The legitimate interest processing includes engaging with contacts, storing their details and undertaking market research activity – but not direct marketing.

To achieve the following purposes: Purpose 3: Commercial booking process

Our legal reason to use the data is: Use is necessary for the performance of a contract with you or to take steps, at your request, before entering into such a contract. That contract being between the UHI NWH and businesses, organisations and other parties to provide commercial educational and other products and/or services and to complete a sales transaction in relation to the same.

Transfer outside the UK

Retention
